

## 1.1 General Policy Statement



## 1.1.2 Environmental Policy Statement

Although by its nature scaffolding does not produce a permanent effect on the projects with which we are involved, the directors recognise the need to minimise our environmental impact in all aspects of our business.

Ray Seager Scaffolding Services Limited is committed to achieving environmental best practice where ever possible and to aiming towards the principles of ISO EN 14001.

Our Policy includes the following:

1. Efficient use of natural resources including:
  - Purchase of timber products from managed sustainable sources.
  - Re-cycling of scrap paper within the office
2. Efficient use of energy including:
  - Minimising use of power by switching off unnecessary lights and electrical equipment.
  - Insulation of offices to better than statutory requirements.
3. Prevention of unnecessary pollution including:
  - Use of environmentally friendly lubricants for scaffold fittings.
  - Safe storage of fuel oils to prevent ingress into local water courses.
  - Careful planning of deliveries to avoid unnecessary journeys.
  - Safe disposal of printer/copier cartridges.
4. Reduction of environmental impact during site works including:
  - Adherence to any site specific environmental restrictions raised by main contractors.
  - Avoidance of unnecessary disturbance of flora and fauna during erection of scaffolding in countryside locations.

In addition to the above, the Director will liaise with clients and customers to develop our policy in relation to particular projects and current best practice.
